Primary Sports & PR Funding 2015-2016

The government is providing additional funding of over £450 million over the next academic years to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding – provided jointly by the Department of Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport – is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. The PR and sport premium is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PR and sport activities they offer their pupils. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but have the freedom to choose how they do this. At Princess May we are committed to ensuring our children understand the importance of being active. Having a healthy lifestyle and enjoy sports and games activities. Below is an overview of how we have decided to use this funding in 2016-2017. Princess May has been allocated £9,710.
