# Dear parents and carers,

What a busy week it's been in school. Children have settled back in well and have valued the structured routines we provide here at school. Our Curriculum Leaflets outline the key learning taking place each half term across our broad and balanced curriculum. Year Group Morning Boosters and the National Tutoring programme will also commence next week. If your child has been selected to take part this term, please ensure that they attend each session.
