

Dear parents and carers,

It has been a great week back here at school. Children's punctuality and attendance has been outstanding, and I am very pleased to say that today we had no children arriving after 8:55am, which allows all children to begin their learning immediately at 9am. In addition, those arriving at 8:45am get an even better deal, as all teachers now provide morning work, which children can access as soon as they arrive.
