### School Street Zone—Penalty Charge Reminder

Princess May has been permanently situated within a Hackney School Street Zone since June 2021. This means that pedestrians and cyclists are prioritised at school start and finish times during term time. **This means that you must not drive your vehicle into Princess May Road, Barrett's Grove, Wordsworth Road and Cressington Close between:**

- 8:30am - 09:30am
- 3:00pm - 4:00pm

If you drive into these roads between these times during term time you may receive a Penalty Charge from the Council. The school has no responsibility for operating the zone in any way.
