### A Message from the Headteacher

Dear parents and carers,

I would like to draw your attention to a set of resources that can be used at home to educate yourselves and your children on online safety.

We are seeing an increasing number of incidents where children are using the internet/devices at home without the correct supervision or parental controls. The internet can be a real minefield, and we understand it can be difficult to know how best to navigate it. Childnet has produced a set of videos, aimed at 6-9 year olds (although I would suggest you may be happy to show them to younger or older children at home, based on your assessment) and reinforce a 'SMART' message for how to behave safely online.
