

In **Art** we will be replicating our version of Starry Night by Vincent van Gogh

In **Topic** we will be looking at a significant event in history. We will be looking at the recorded event of when the first man landed on the moon. We will be sequencing events, objects or pieces of information about time travel on a timeline. We will make labelled drawings, tables and write sentences, speak (including in drama) and use ICT to show our ideas
