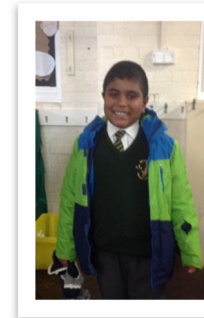
School Dinners

Wearing bright colours especially in the winter when it gets dark early.

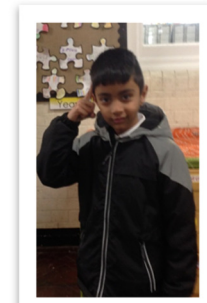
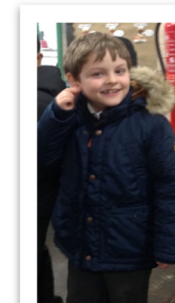
