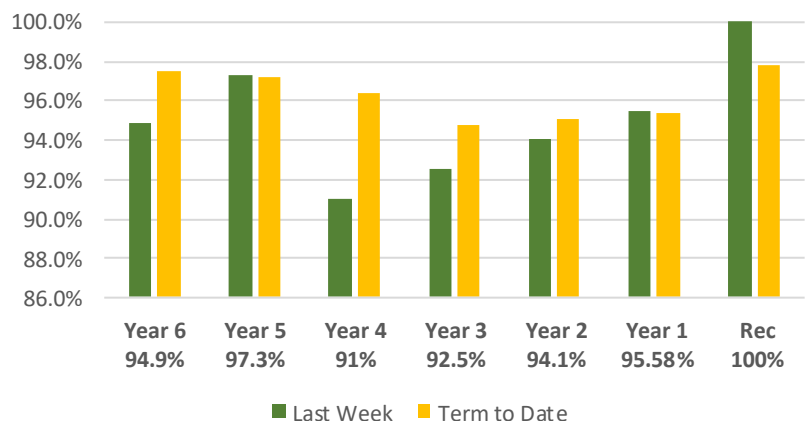


School Library

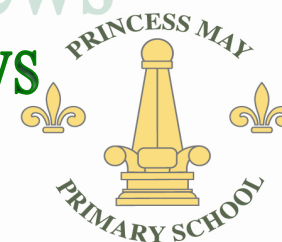
