Dear parents and carers,

Year 6 return to school

We are writing to give you more detailed information regarding your Year 6 child returning to school on Monday 8th June.

First and foremost, it goes without saying that the safety of your child and of our staff is our top priority. We are working hard, following the latest government guidance, to develop and implement a number of new ways of operating. This will allow us to open as safely as possible, focusing on measures that will help limit the risk of coronavirus transmitting within our school setting.

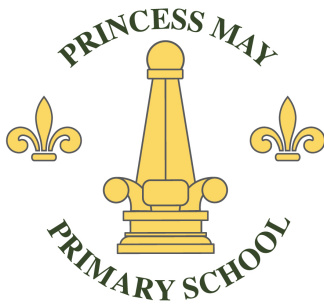
We ask that anyone who is displaying coronavirus symptoms, or who lives with someone who does, not to attend school and informs the school immediately.

Expectations

- Do not arrive at school before 9:30am (there will be NO breakfast club)
- Parents and carers who escort their child to school are to drop Year 6 children at the **Princess May Road gate (labelled entrance/exit Year 6)** and are not permitted on the premises (parents are asked to 'drop and go')
- Year 6 children will only use the **Princess May Road gate (labelled entrance/exit Year 6)** to enter and leave the school premises
- If you are collecting your child at the end of the day, please always wait outside of the school gate and adhere to social distancing rules
- Children are expected to be dressed in their Princess May school uniform; trainers are permitted footwear as PE will be daily (NO changing into PE kits)
- Children entitled to a free school meal will be provided with a school packed lunch (to be eaten in their classroom)
- All other children will be required to bring a packed lunch each day in a small lunch bag only (NO rucksacks or other bags permitted)
- All children are to bring with them their own labelled water bottle (bottles must be taken home and cleaned daily)
- NO other personal equipment is permitted e.g. pencil case, reading book, book bag, mobile phones

School day

- We will continue to use Oak Academy on teams so that children at home/in school will be receiving the same learning
- Children to be taught in groups of no more than 10 on average; each group will remain isolated from the others in the school, including during break and lunch times, with 1 dedicated adult
- Children will be assigned an individual desk
- Each child will be provided with a school pack that will include all resources that they require, this pack will be kept in school on their desk and cleaned each day
- Children will eat their lunch at their assigned desk (school lunch hall will not be in use)
- Staggered break and lunch times with play equipment removed and social distancing maintained where possible
