### **Reception pupils' home learning**

We know that the decision to either send your child back to school or continue with home learning has been a difficult one. I want to reaffirm that the school will continue to support your child with home learning, weekly phone calls and free school meals vouchers, where you are entitled to these, now that you have made the decision to keep your child at home. Teachers will continue to set home learning for Reception children for the remainder of the summer term through Microsoft Teams, and children should interact with this in the same way they have been. I would also like to take this opportunity to thank you for supporting your child in their use of Teams since the school closure. Children and parents have adapted incredibly quickly to this new way of learning, and it has been great to see such high-quality interactions between staff and pupils.

As mentioned to you in my letter yesterday, it is important for us to have certainty on the number of pupils attending so that we can maintain social distancing, where possible.
