



Addendum to School Behaviour Policy
Academic year 2020/21
Home-School Agreement (to be signed by all)

Please read closely in conjunction with the existing school behaviour policy and Covid-19 risk assessment (published on the school website)

School

As a school, we agree to:

- Promote new routines and health and safety behaviours, in order for everyone to succeed as learners and responsible citizens
- Insist that adults/children wash hands thoroughly for 20 seconds with soap and water or use the hand dispensers provided on arrival at the setting, or when staff go across bubbles, before and after eating, and after sneezing or coughing.
- Promote good respiratory hygiene by following the guidance of **'Catch it; bin it; kill it'** (e.g. using a tissue when sneezing and coughing and putting in a lidded bin).
- Treat deliberate acts of transmission with the greatest seriousness and use the strongest sanctions available.
- Ensure there is a thorough cleaning routine across the school, including frequently touched surfaces and items or spaces shared across bubbles (kept to a minimum)
- Ensure that bubbles are self-contained, including at break and lunchtimes
- Ensure that the same teacher(s) and other staff are assigned to each bubble and, as far as possible, these stay the same during the day.
- Ensure that wherever possible, children and adults use the same classroom or area of a setting throughout the day and minimise their footprint across the premises.
- Encourage children and adults not to touch their mouth, eyes and nose.
- Prop doors open, where safe to do so (bearing in mind fire safety and safeguarding), to limit use of door handles and aid ventilation.
- Ensure that toilets do not become crowded by limiting the number of children who use the toilet facilities at one time and regularly cleaning these.

Children

As a pupil, I agree to:

- Follow new school rules and routines and expected behaviours to keep myself, my school community and my family safe.
- Keep the school resources that I am given to use in my plastic zip pack.
- Try to keep a 2 metre distance between my teacher/ adults and other children.
- Use a tissue to **'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it'** when sneezing or coughing and put these in the lidded bins around the school.
- Be responsible for keeping my water bottle with me at all times and not to share this.

- Make sure that I wash my hands or use hand gel on arrival at school, before and after eating, and after sneezing or coughing.
- Follow the directions of the footprints on the floor when moving around the school and only when asked to by an adult
- Respect the personal space of others (e.g. no hugging, touching or holding hands).
- To always follow instructions of adults
- To always behave in a safe and responsible manner

Parents/ Carers

As a parent/carer, I agree to:

- Support the school in promoting their new school routines and health and safety behaviours in order for my child/ren to succeed academically and as a member of the school community.
- Accept that any unsafe behaviour from children puts the health of our whole-school community in jeopardy, and that the school will use the strongest possible sanctions when this occurs: **we expect all parents to fully support us when this happens**
- Ensure that my child arrives at school on time so that bubbles do not mix when arriving at school
- Collect my child on time at the end of the day so that bubbles do not mix at the end of the day
- Ensure that my child's clothing is changed/washed regularly.
- Provide my child with a labelled water bottle that I will ensure is cleaned each day.
- Ensure that my child **only** brings to school their labelled water bottle and packed lunch (Those eligible for Free School Meals will be provided a packed lunch).
- Ensure my child comes to school in their P.E kit on their P.E days
- Respect the 2-metre social distancing guidance and not gather in groups outside the school gates.
- Ensure that you organise a test for your child, in the event that they develop coronavirus symptoms, and notify us immediately of the test outcome.
- Attend school within 1 hour to collect my child/children should their bubble be sent home
