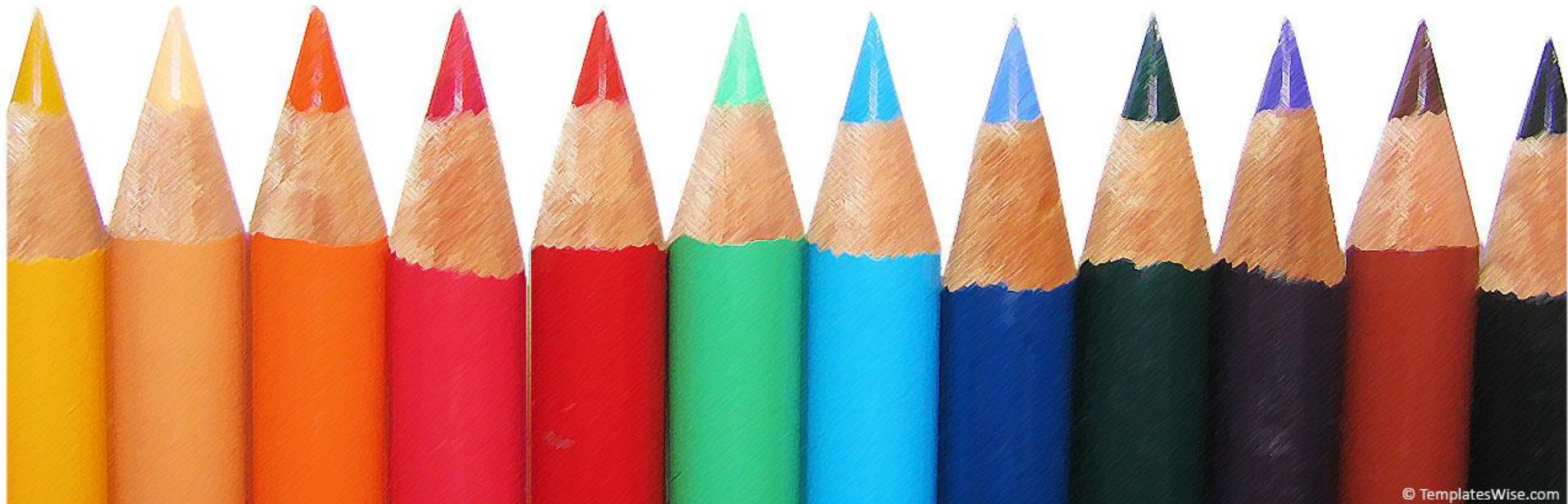

# Attendance and Punctuality

- Children are expected to attend school everyday.
- If attendance falls below 92% they are classified as persistent absentees.
- Good attendance is rewarded.
- If your child is sick, you must call the office to report this.
- Permission will not be given for holidays in term time and you may be fined.
- School starts at 9:10am at Princess May Road main gate. Please be on time.
- Punctuality is a focus this term.

# Uniform

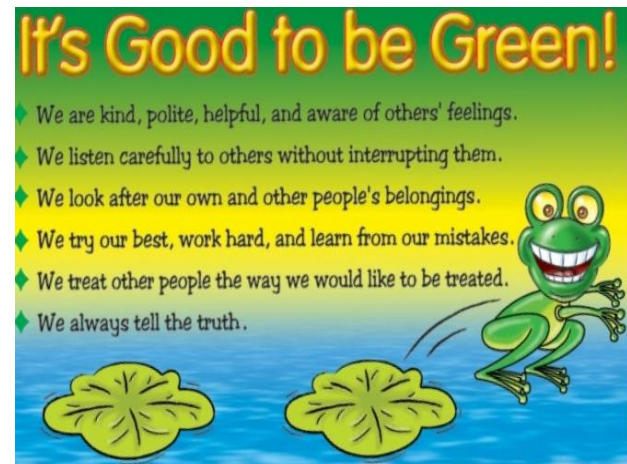
- School uniform is compulsory. School jumper and tie, white shirt and grey trousers/skirt.
- Shoes need to be black.

# School Lunches

- School lunches cost £1.80 per day or £9 per week. All payments for lunches are made through Parent Pay.
- Lunches are free for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.
- If you are eligible please apply for Free school meals via Hackney Learning Trust. (including children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 as we get extra funding)

- Packed lunches need to be healthy. No sweets, sugary drinks, cakes.
- No Nuts: We have children with allergies.
- You cannot switch between packed lunches and school lunches. You will need to give half a term's notice to the office.

# Behaviour-Stay on Green

- Children begin each day on **green**.
- **Inappropriate** behaviour is challenged with a **blue card**. The child is given an opportunity to self regulate in order to remain on green behaviour.
- A **yellow card** is then given so that children have a chance to modify their behaviour.
- **Continued misbehaviour** leads to name moved to **RED** with **10 minutes time out of the class**.
- **On return to class child is put back on GREEN.**
- **Positive** behaviour is rewarded with **silver then gold**



# National Curriculum Levels of Achievement

What level should your child achieve at the end of Year 2?

There are three levels of achievement:

- working towards the level expected
- working at the level expected
- exceeding the expected level

# Support

Children are generally expected to make one level's progress over two school years.

Children working above or below expected levels will have their needs addressed through differentiated daily lessons or targeted support. These may include additional adult intervention, focused group work or one-to-one teaching.

Daily supported reading.

30 minutes of levelled reading at 9:15am.

Daily 45 minutes reading and writing lessons taught through a synthetic phonics programme.

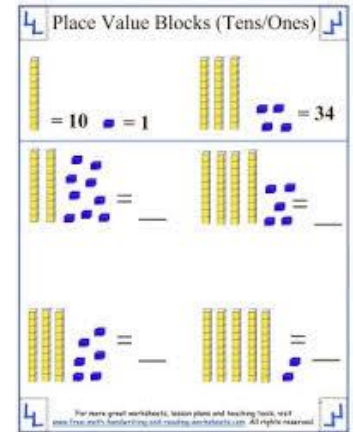
## Maths Mastery

# Numeracy at home

- Count on and back in 1,2,5,10s, 3s and 4s from any given number to 100.
- Read, write and order numbers from 0 to at least 100; understand and use the vocabulary of comparing and ordering these numbers. Children need to master numbers to 100 to be able to manipulate numbers above 100 with ease.
- Within a range of 0 to 100, say the number that is 1 or 10 more or less than any given number.
- Understand the operation of addition, and of subtraction (as 'take away' or 'difference'), and use the related vocabulary.
- Know by heart all pairs of numbers within a total of 20.
- Use mental strategies to solve simple problems using counting, addition, subtraction, doubling and halving, explaining methods and reasoning orally.



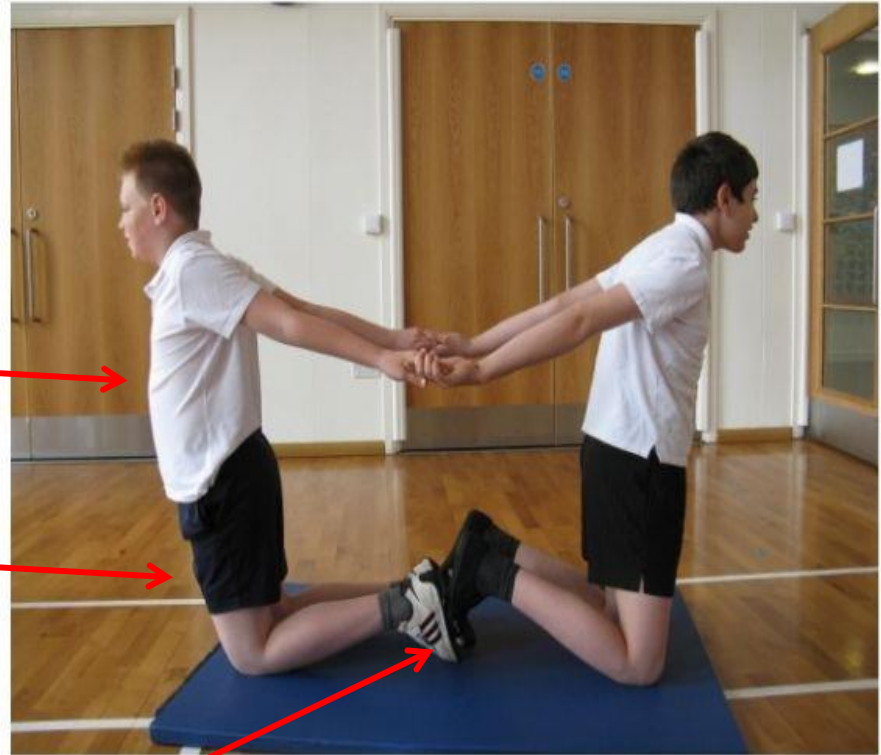
# P.E.
