Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to another year at Princess May. I hope that you have had a restful summer break and are ready for the new term.

I am personally very excited to be starting the school year as part of the Princess May community. In my short time here before the holiday, I spoke to many of you, both informally and formally, about the things you like in school and indeed the things you believe could be improved. I have taken this on board and I am certain that you will see some positive changes over the coming months, as well as the school continuing all of the excellent work that it already does.

You will know from recent communications that we are trialing new entry and exit arrangements in the mornings and afternoons. I thank you for your patience with this as we all adjust to the new system. Just a reminder that the gate will open each morning at 8:40am (please do not arrive before this time as this may cause congestion outside of the gates) and close at precisely 9am each morning. Anyone arriving after 9am will be directed to the school office entrance on Princess May Road, where they will need to sign in as late. There will be a big drive to improve punctuality this term and I very much hope that you will support us with this important initiative by arriving before or at 8:55am each morning. In the afternoons, the gate on Barrett's Grove will open at 3:15pm. Again, please avoid arriving earlier than this to avoid causing congestion on Barrett's Grove. I would also kindly ask that once your child has been dropped off in the mornings, that you aim to leave the site promptly.

I very much look forward to working with you all over the coming school year. Please keep an eye out for next week's newsletter as I will be announcing the weekly parent drop-in sessions, which I hope will be well-attended.
