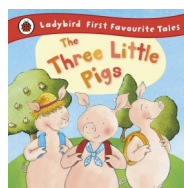
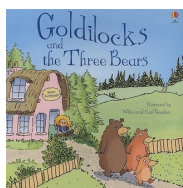




NURSERY – SPRING 1 – EXPLORE

Communication & Language

We will listen to longer stories and try to remember what happens.



How to help your child at home:

Share a book with your child everyday and encourage them to talk about pictures and the story.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We are thinking about the perspectives of others and how to respect other's feelings.



How to help your child at home:

Talk to your child about how they can be kind to others.

Physical Development

We will practice skills such as cutting with scissors and modelling to strengthen the muscles in our hands. We will play a variety of ball games in the outdoors.



How to help your child at home:

Make playdough together at home. Your child is familiar with making playdough at nursery and has great fun making and playing with it!

Literacy

Literacy: mark making

We will use a range of mark making tools and media to develop our drawing/writing skills

How to help your child at home:

Please read with your child every day. Encourage your child to draw and write at home. Talk to your child about their pictures.

Mathematics

We will consolidate our number skills to five. We will be exploring size and measure.



How to help your child at home:

Encourage your child to touch each object as they count to five.

Understanding the World

We will observe nature in Winter and describe the changes. We will find out about the celebration of Chinese New Year.



How to help your child at home:
