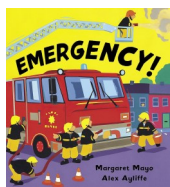




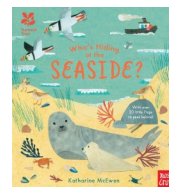
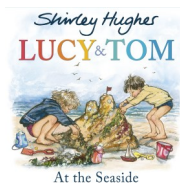
NURSERY – SUMMER 2 – CREATE

Welcome to Nursery! This half term, we will be learning about life-cycles and how things grow. We will observe the changes in nature and explore buildings in London, as well as the Queen.

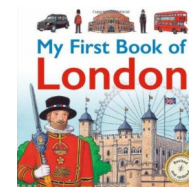

Physical Development

We will begin to use core muscle strength to achieve a good posture when sitting at the table and on the floor. We will also explore how to move confidently in a range of ways, safely negotiating space.

How to help your child at home:

Encourage your child to have a good posture when sitting at a table for dinner.

Personal, Social &

Emotional Development

We will develop appropriate ways of being assertive and solving conflicts showing sensitivity to others needs and feelings.

How to help your child at home:

Encourage your child to express themselves during moments of frustration using their words.

Communication & Language

We will use new sounds to begin to segment and blend CVC words using objects to support. We will also begin to develop own narratives by connecting ideas.

How to help your child at home:

Encourage your child to create their own narrative. Reinforce the new words of the week which is sent home weekly.

Literacy

We will continue to write our own names and forming letters correctly, as well as reinforcing RWI Set 1.

How to help your child at home:

Practice recognising each weeks sound when you are out and about, e.g. look for them on street signs.

Mathematics

We will make comparisons between objects related to size, length, weight and capacity. We will also begin to find one more/ less from a given number to 5 and use the language of position.

How to help your child at home:

Practise describing a familiar route with your child, e.g. your journey to school. Cook together to begin exploring sizes, e.g. capacity and weight.

Understanding the World

We will be exploring different occupations, e.g. Emergency services. We will also explore and talk about different forces that we can feel and find out more about the Natural World.

How to help your child at home:

Talk to your child about yours or others occupations.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be inventing and adapting for a clear purpose in mind. We will also explore artists such as Katsushika Hokusai, David Hockney and Joseph Mallord William Turner.

How to help your child at home:

Try to visit the seaside with your child.
